<u>Prerequisites:</u>	Firefighter I
<u>Course Information:</u>	Based on Chief Jon Salka's "Get Out Alive" program. This program is designed for self rescue and rescue of trapped Firefighters. This course requires students to perform a number of practical evolutions focusing on self extrication, disorientation, and Firefighter separation in an emergency situation. Turn out gear and SCBA required.

Student enrollment is limited to 18.

Pre-registration is required and no one will be admitted without pre-registration. Pre-registration can be accomplished by completing the enclosed form (Fire Bureau Student Registration Form) and returning it to the Fire Bureau (hand deliver, mail or FAX to 753-3867). The deadline for registration is **October 7, 2010.**
