FIRE TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

Firefighter Survival

Course #: 01-05-0022

Based on Chief John Salka's "Get Out Alive" program, this program is designed for self-rescue and rescue of trapped firefighters. Course content will enable firefighters to recognize the types of events encountered on the fireground that contribute to firefighter disorientation and/or entrapment; to have knowledge of what is necessary to ensure their safety and that of their partners or crew members; and to perform self-rescue techniques when disoriented, separated, or needing to exit a structure in an emergency.

This course requires students to perform a number of practical evolutions with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA).

Designed For: Fire Service Personnel

Course Length: 12 Hours

Prerequisite: Firefighter I (01-05-0019). The nationally recognized Firefighter Level I certification may be substituted for the course prerequisite. Students must also be physically capable of wearing SCBA and possess current medical clearance for SCBA use. Students not possessing this prerequisite will not be allowed to participate for their own safety.
